I look forward to seeing you out and about enjoying our City this summer.

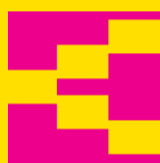

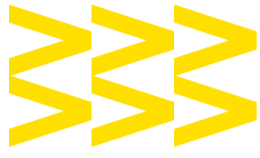
## GET OUT AND GET ACTIVE
